

UC864 modules contains a fully featured HSDPA modem and UMTS/GSM/GPRS module, compatible with the other Telit GSM/GPRS modules.

CC864 modules contains a fully features CDMA modem compatible with the other Telit GSM/GPRS modules.

2 Requisites

Below are the HW and SW requisites to install CC/UC864 module:

- PC with Windows 2000, XP, Vista and 7 OS installed,
- CC86/UC864 module,
- CC864/UC864 USB Drivers for Windows 2000, XP, Vista and 7 (to get the driver, please contact Telit Support (TS-EMEA@telit.com)).



3 USB driver download and installation

The TelitUSBInstaller.exe file needs to be available on the PC used for the income procedure.

To install the USB driver follow the following steps:


1. Download driver archive and uncompress it in a specific directory (e.g. c:\Telit_Usb_driver) to be selected afterwards during the installation procedure.
2. Start TelitUSBInstaller.exe application.



3. Click “Next >” button to install the driver.





4. If appear one of these windows click "Continue Anyway" or "Install this driver software anyway".




5. The driver is now installed, click now "Finish" to close the installer application.






At the end of the installation 3 ports are finally installed in the system:

- a) Telit HSDPA USB Modem
- b) Telit Auxiliary port
- c) Telit Diagnostic interface

In case modem provides Nmea port 4 ports are installed in the system:

- Telit HSDPA USB Modem
- Telit Auxiliary port
- Telit Diagnostic interface
- Telit Nmea Port






4 Dial-Up Connection

4.1 Creation of dialup connection on HSDPA USB Modem port


To create a Dial-Up connection:

1. Click on Start->Control Panel. Then click on “Network and Internet connections” as shown in the following picture.

- Click on “Create a connection to the network at your workspace”




- Tick “Dial-up connection” checkbox , then click “Next”.



4. Check the “Modem – Telit HSDPA USB Modem” then click “Next” checkbox. Please note that the example reported is related to the installation of one of the Telit Uc864 modules.



5. Type a name for the new connection then click “Next”

6. Type the phone number “*99***1#” then click “Next”.



8. Check "Add a shortcut.." checkbox then Click "Finish" to complete the procedure.




4.2 Connect using Dial-Up (USB mode)

or click Start→Connect to→UC864 Terminal – HSDPA







Click “Dial” in “Connect UC864 Terminal” window
