

## **What is RSS?**

RSS (Really Simple Site Syndication or Rich Site Summary) provides a timely way to gather content from multiple websites. You save time by not visiting websites individually and can quickly get information about press releases, documentation revisions, product updates, and any other relevant changes to a website – automatically delivered to your desktop or email.

A “feed” is a small amount of content that is sent to an RSS Reader. The “feed” is usually the headline of the content that you are going to be viewing. In the RSS Reader, you can view “feeds” from a variety of webpage’s that offer RSS, and have the ability to view the complete content by clicking on the “feed” headline that appears interesting to you.

## **Where can I get an RSS reader?**

To view RSS content you must have an RSS reader. There are plenty of RSS readers that are free and some that have a small fee. Once you have selected and installed an RSS reader, refer to the reader’s instructions to configure your settings.

## **How to sign up for Janus RSS Feeds?**

You should already be in the Janus site. If not, visit our website: [www.janus-rc.com](http://www.janus-rc.com) and look for the RSS Icon on the right hand side of the website. By clicking on the RSS logo you’re directed to another page, copy the URL located on top of the address bar and then follow your RSS reader instructions. You should paste the URL link wherever it asks for the location of the service of which you wish to subscribe.
